



Mail cutoff means Guard coming home soon

GALVA -- It's a sign the Galva National Guard unit will be coming home soon.

The unit's Family Support Group has received word from Maj. Michael Kessel, commander, that no packages should be mailed to members of Battery F, 202nd Air Defense Artillery at their current address after Saturday (Jan. 15).

No letters or mail of any kind should be mailed after Tuesday, Jan. 25.

"Maj. Kessel explained that after those dates, the soldiers will be too hard to track down with mail," said Pat Newman of the Family Support Group.

The 120 members of Foxtrot Battery have been in Iraq since March and will soon be making their way home, a process which could take up to two months, depending on developments in their area of operation.
