## **Kewanee brothers both serving in Iraq**

BAGHDAD, Iraq -- Two brothers from Kewanee are now serving in Iraq -- one recently arrived with Battery F, 1st Battalion, 202nd Air Defense Artillery of the Illinois National Guard based in Galva, while the other has been there the past year and was set to come home when his tour was extended this month.
