

Charred, twisted wreckage is all that's left of the almost unrecognizable humvee in which SPC Dustin Hill of Annawan was riding as gunner when it was hit Sept. 21, 2004, by a suicide car bomber on the airport road in Baghdad. The other four soldiers in the patrol from the Galva National Guard unit were outside the vehicle at the time and sustained minor injuries. Hill was badly burned on the head, face, neck and arms and lost his right eye and both hands.
